

PLANTING SOILBLOCKS AND FERTILPOTS

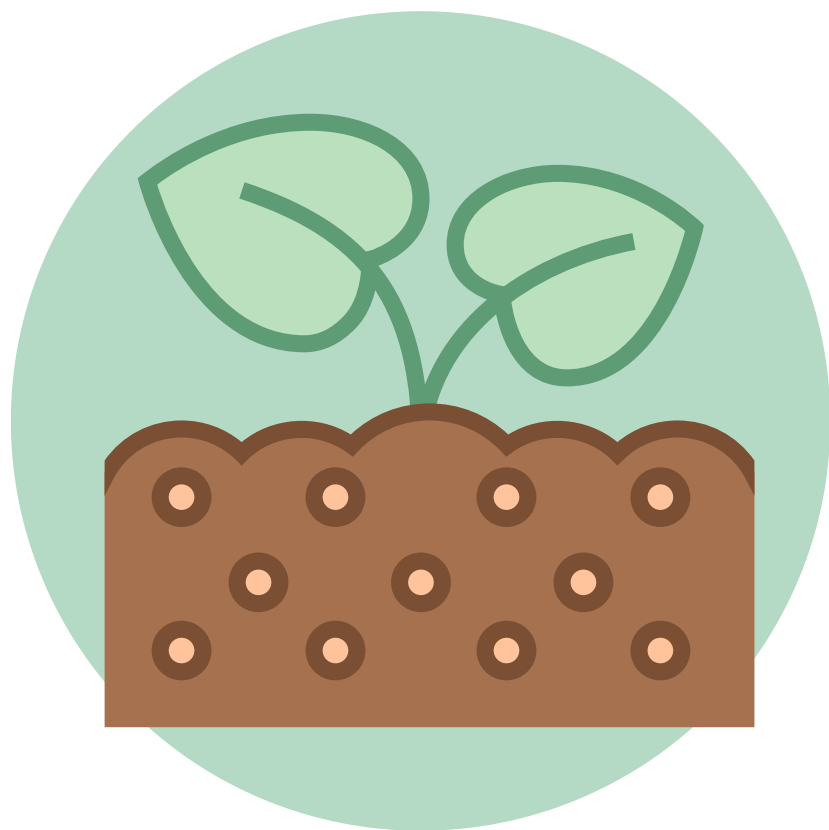


STEP 1: PREPARE THE SITE

Choose your location depending on the light and soil requirement of your plant. Most plants need well drained soil and partial to direct sunlight. Remove weeds and add fertilizer (if any).

STEP 2: TRANSPLANTING

Make sure your seedling is well watered. Dig a hole deep enough to set entire soilblock or Fertilpot below ground level and 50% wider. Fertilpot is biodegradable, do NOT remove seedling from it.



IMPORTANT!

The top of the soilblock and/or Fertilpot should be buried slightly below soil level. Compress slightly the soil around the base of your plant to limit drying out, then water thoroughly.

STEP 4: CARING

Make sure that your plant does not dry out during the first few days until the roots have started to extend beyond the pot.
